Criteria for assessing online homework

- Punctuality
- Multiple choice and gap fill questions
 - *correct answer*
- Word order questions
 - *Correct order*
 - *Spelling*
 - *Punctuation*
- Long form answers (including answering written and spoken questions)
 - *Correct word order*
 - *Spelling*
 - *Punctuation*
 - *Relevant information and grammar*
 - *Use of taught/target language*

Criteria for assessing student presentations

- Grammar
 - *Use of taught grammar*
 - *Correct tense*
- Fluency
 - *Pronunciation (in particular, no katakana English)*
 - *Smooth and natural speed*
- Structure
 - *Properly, logically structured talk*
 - *Clear talking points*
- Confidence
 - *Eye contact*
 - *Audience interaction*
 - *Error correction*
- Use of materials
 - *Good presentation materials*
 - *Proper/minimal use of notes*
 - *Correspondence of talking points and screens*
- Content
 - *Originality*
 - *Follows taught pattern*

Criteria for assessing reading homework

- Punctuality
- Not graded if the book has been submitted before by the same student
- Not graded if the questions are not properly answered
- Not graded if the answers are copied from somebody or somewhere else
- Not graded if it is obvious the student did not read the book
