## Criteria for assessing online homework

- Punctuality
- · Multiple choice and gap fill questions
  - correct answer
- · Word order questions
  - Correct order
  - Spelling
  - Punctuation
- Long form answers (including answering written and spoken questions)
  - Correct word order
  - Spelling
  - Punctuation
  - Relevant information and grammar
  - Use of taught/target language

## Criteria for assessing student presentations

- Grammar
  - Use of taught grammar
  - Correct tense
- Fluency
  - Pronunciation (in particular, no katakana English)
  - Smooth and natural speed
- Structure
  - Properly, logically structured talk
  - Clear talking points
- Confidence
  - Eye contact
  - Audience interaction
  - Error correction
- Use of materials
  - Good presentation materials
  - Proper/minimal use of notes
  - · Correspondence of talking points and screens
- Content
  - Originality
  - Follows taught pattern

## Criteria for assessing reading homework

- · Punctuality
- · Not graded if the book has been submitted before by the same student
- Not graded if the questions are not properly answered
- Not graded if the answers are copied from somebody or somewhere else
- Not graded if it is obvious the student did not read the book

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
